2019 Schoff's Hill Cabernet Sauvignon

Grape Variety: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Origin Country: Australia

Region of Production: Barossa Valley (Single Vineyard, Estate Grown)

Winemaking Notes:

A complex wine that is powerful yet fragrant; seriously tannic yet with allure and richness. Cabernet grows exceptionally well at Pindarie. Our single block is on the western slope of what we know as Schoff's Hill, the highest elevation at our vineyard. Planted on prized terra rossa soil, the vines produce small berries, consistently producing an award winning concentrated wine year after year. Minimal handling once picked, destemmed then fermented long and slow, before being put into expensive French oak for a long sleep. We ensure that oak and typical Cabernet structure are present but subtle, so the varietal characters are forever present.

Picking Season: 27th February 2019

Cellaring: 10 years

Alcohol: 15.0%

Sugar Residual: 0.22 g/l

T.A. (Acidity): 6.33 g/l

Tasting Note:

Our vines produce powerfully-fragrant fruit and so have chosen to release the wine relatively young. As the aroma and perfume is best captured in its youth. The warmth of our vineyard on the Western Ridge of the Barossa means that the perfume is in the red berry, blackcurrant spectrum (cassis), and ensures a wine of charm at an early age, with pronounced but even and round tannins. Being Cabernet it will cellar beautifully, but age is not essential for enjoyment.

Ideal with a range of cuisine, especially dishes with lamb or pork.
