Grape Variety: 100% Shiraz Origin Country: Australia

Region of Production: Barossa Valley (Single Vineyard, Estate Grown).

Winemaking Notes:

Shiraz is a genuine chameleon, capable of making the rich, full-bodied reds that the Barossa is famous for... and when the right block is picked at the right time, it can also make terrific fresh sparkling or still rosé. We carefully allowed a small period of contact between juice and skins after harvest, to ensure a pretty shade of pink – and more importantly, some lovely floral aromas and flavours. Teamed with the fizz that just spells 'fun', the fruit intensity ensures that our fine, delicate sparkler is a delight!

Vineyard Report:

The '23 vintage was cooler and later than normal, ensuring that the fruit retained terrific natural acidity – essential for sparkling wine of all styles – and the development of lively, fragrant fruit character relatively early in the ripening process. The result is a fragrant, pink and lively sparkler!

Picking Season: 21st February 2023

Alcohol: 12.5%

Sugar Residual: 13 g/l T.A. (Acidity): 7.1 g/l
